



KOKODA TRACK MEMORIAL WALKWAY

FORMAT OF SCHOOL VISIT

Thank you for your interest in the Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway.
Below is an indicative format of a school excursion.

1. On arrival between 9:30–10:00am, students are directed to the Ralph Honner Education Centre.
2. Students and teachers are welcomed by veteran guides to the Walkway, and housekeeping details provided.
3. This is followed by a video clip showing the start of WWII and how the war made its way to the Pacific. Students are then given an immersive experience of being on the Track using virtual reality (VR) program and equipment.
4. Students will then have the opportunity to participate in a wreath laying ceremony at the Memorial before being placed into small groups accompanied by a veteran guide and taken on walk. Students are encouraged to read historical material along the Walkway and to seek information from the guides on the New Guinea campaign.
5. The guided walk concludes at approximately 12:30pm. Students stop for lunch before departure. If the school is sponsored by their local RSL, the sausage sizzle is included in the excursion.
6. Departure time is approximately 1:30pm.
7. Students are encouraged to complete a feedback form on their experience before departure.

Note: Times are a guide only and may depend on the size of the group.
