



KOKODA TRACK MEMORIAL WALKWAY

FUNCTION AREA/BBQ FACILITY CONDITIONS OF USE

1. Payment Fee

The fee for the use of the Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway (KTMW) covered function area/BBQ facility must be paid prior to use.

If your function does not proceed due to inclement weather, the fee will be held in credit for your next booking. Email admin@kokodawalkway.com.au to advise of non-use due to weather.

2. Non-Exclusive Use of BBQ Area

Booking of covered function area/BBQ facility at the Kokoda Track Memorial does not give the applicant exclusive use of the facility.

The covered function area/BBQ facility can accommodate up to 70 people comfortably. In instances where applicant's number fall well short of the capacity, the facility may be open to other applicants. If you are to share the area you will receive notification of this prior to your booking date.

3. Tables/Chairs/Decorations

Set up of tables, chairs and decorations is permitted. Applicants are however responsible for removing all decorations and rubbish before departing or a clean-up fee of \$100 will be levied.

4. Sale/Consumption of Alcohol

No alcohol is permitted to be sold. Alcohol is only allowed to be consumed if applicant provides notification at the time of booking.

5. Amusement Devices & Temporary Structures

NO amusement devices and temporary structures (such as marquees, tents, gazebos, jumping castles, etc) are permitted at the facility or in the open space of the Memorial. The only exception will be official functions organised by the KTMW or the City of Canada Bay Council.

6. Waste/Litter

The Applicant shall ensure that the covered function area/BBQ facility and the area around the facility are left in a clean and tidy condition after use or a clean-up fee of \$100 will be levied. Please ensure that the BBQ plate/top is cleaned after use and that all rubbish is placed in the provided rubbish bins.

7. Electrical Access

Electrical outlets are provided and are found under the benches either end of the BBQ.

8. Sink

The sink and tap are available for your usage. The tap is automatic and only provides cold water. Please leave the sink strainer in place.

Please clean the sink after use and do not flush chemicals or foreign items into the sink.

9. No Feeding of Birds or Wildlife

Feeding of the birds, or leaving food out for any wildlife, is not permitted.

Do not damage any plants, facilities or disturb the wildlife while using the covered function area/BBQ facility.

10. Open Fires

No open fires are to be lit in the BBQ area or in the open space of the Memorial.

11. Care with Children

Parents are reminded that the area is a memorial which pays respect to those who have served and/or lost their lives defending our country. Parents are expected to supervise children at all times. Wading in the creek and climbing on the Memorial Stations and the Centrepiece rock are prohibited.

12. Dogs

Dogs are allowed in Rhodes Park but must always be on a leash and under control.

13. Respect our Neighbours

Noise is to be kept to a reasonable level and loud amplified music is not permitted.

14. Lost and Found

Any items left in the function area/BBQ will be stored for 3 months. Please contact admin@kokodawalkway.com.au for collection of any items.
