



Miscellaneous Deaths

The following were listed in Bill James's *Field Guide to the Kokoda Track* as having died of various causes during the Kokoda and Beachheads campaigns (but generally not attributed to any specific battle/skirmish). Most listed 'died on active service', from illness, injury, misadventure etc., often dying in Port Moresby after being evacuated there. Those marked with an * are listed in the [Kokoda Honour Roll](#) (with explanatory notes), following research which indicated their deaths were caused by, or during, active service during the actual Kokoda campaign.
