



Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway Memorial Rose Garden – Commemorative Plaques



The Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway stretches along the shores of Brays Bay, connecting Concord Repatriation General Hospital to Rhodes Station. It tells the story of the battles fought along the Kokoda Track in New Guinea and stands as a lasting tribute to all Australian veterans who served in World War II.

Dedicate a Plaque to Someone Special

Each individual plaque is crafted from fine-cast bronze, measuring approximately 20cm x 15cm, and features the veteran's name, rank, service number, and unit. You can also include a personal message of up to 100 characters – a meaningful touch that makes the tribute truly your own.

Plaques are mounted along the circular wall framing the Memorial Rose Garden.

Cost of a Plaque

The cost of an individual Memorial Plaque is \$350.00, which covers War Graves approval for the relevant service emblem (Navy, Army, or Air Force), artwork, casting, and wall mounting.

Timeline

Once you have approved the artwork, allow 6–8 weeks for casting and mounting. Please note that production won't begin until all artwork details have been verified and signed off.
